## Home energy saving tips

- LED light bulbs use about 75 percent less energy than incandescent bulbs.
- Turn off lights, power strips and computers when they're not in use.
- Home appliances expel heat while in use. Using them outside of afternoon daytime hours will keep your house cooler.
- Replace your air filters on a regular basis to reduce strain on your HVAC system.
- Using a programmable thermostat to work around your schedule can help save energy and make you more comfortable at home.
- Using a ceiling fan while in a room will help add to your comfort without lowering the thermostat temperature.
- Sealing cracks, gaps, leaks and adding insulation can save up to 10 percent on home heating and cooling costs.
- Closing blinds, shades and drapes on the sunny side of the house will reduce the work for your A/C unit.
- Use ventilation fans sparingly. They replace cooler inside air with warmer outside air.
